<p>OTTERS (<i>Occupational Therapy Teaching, Engaging and Regulating through Swim</i>)</p> <p>Led by an occupational therapist, this group teaches safety awareness, engaging brain/body connections and regulating sensory/behavioral systems through swimming skills to advance basic skills.</p> <p>*Little experience in the water is needed to participate. <p>Novel Ideas</p> <p>Led by a speech-language pathologist, this fun, phonics-based literacy group is for school-aged children who need extra support for reading and writing. It incorporates a multi-modal, play-based approach to structured literacy intervention. <p>Kids in the Kitchen</p> <p>Led by a certified occupational therapy assistant and a speech-language pathologist, this fun hands-on group teaches children basic life skills and promotes independence and safety in the kitchen. Each week, your child will be challenged to use critical thinking and problem-solving skills to develop and execute basic meals and snacks, from planning to cleanup.
